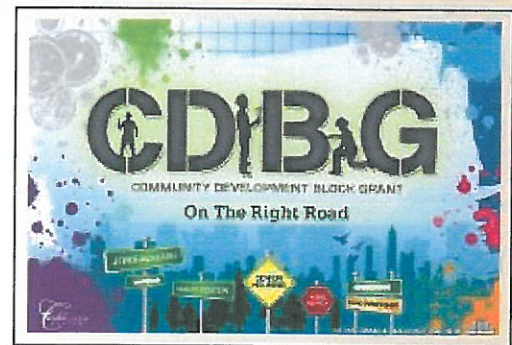
Program Overview

Lexington County receives approximately \$1.4 million dollars annually from the

[US Department of Housing and Urban Development](#). This money is used to implement the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The CDBG Program provides funds for projects that primarily assist low and moderate-income persons in securing:

- Decent housing;
- Suitable living environments;
- and Expanded economic opportunities.

CDBG funds can be used to build community facilities, roads, parks; to repair or rehabilitate housing; to provide new or increased public services to County residents; or to fund initiatives that generate new jobs.



Lexington County's CDBG allocation funds projects in all incorporated and unincorporated areas of the County.

Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development provides flexible grants to help cities, counties, and States recover from Presidentially declared disasters, especially in low-income areas. This CDBG-DR funding from HUD may be used to cover expenses that other funding sources are unable to cover. Lexington County will receive 16.3 million for flood recovery efforts.
